Tech Bytes

Summer-time is really hard on batteries as many of you know. What you may not know is that our car battery requires maintenance to keep it in top shape. Many of our customers have batteries 4+ years old. When you come in for an oil service we check your battery as part of that service. If you haven't had an oil service in more than 6 months it is a good idea to have your battery checked and your battery water level maintained. We can do this anytime your car is in for repair, just ask. Battery failure is one of the few things that will leave your car stranded. No one wants to be stranded in the summer heat!!

During the summer it is not uncommon for your vehicle to run a little warmer than usual; however, your vehicle should never run into the red. Red is a dangerous place to be and can cause engine damage even if you drive in the red for just a few minutes. If you are experiencing overheating, find a safe place to turn the car off right away. Tow the car if necessary but don't drive in the red. A tow bill is cheaper than a damaged engine!!
